Matthew 18:21-35

21 *Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times?*

22 *Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.*

23 *Therefore is the kingdom of heaven likened unto a certain king, which would take account of his servants.*
